### Inside Wire Program Changes

Apprenticeship consists of two components, on the job training (OJT) and related classroom instruction (RSI). Staring with the Class of 2022, the RSI portion of the apprenticeship will be covered in 4-years. The 8000 hour OJT requirement will remain the same. To accomplish this, portions of RSI will now be delivered remotely via video, take home lab work and computer mediated learning. Using these modern methods will strengthen the classroom portion of the apprenticeship by allowing more time in class for hands on training and testing.
