APPRENTICE NEWS

Those of you that already have or will be renewing their trainee card will be notified that all trainee card renewals are required to have 16 hours of electrical basic classroom hours. Do not panic as this law pertains to those who are not in a State registered apprenticeship program. Your apprenticeship classes will be recognized by the State for compliance of this new law.

Make sure and keep your trainee card current. Bring all paper work into the JATC office for notarization and signature. If you let your card lapse, you will not get credit for all hours worked with an expired trainee card and subject to a hefty fine by the State.

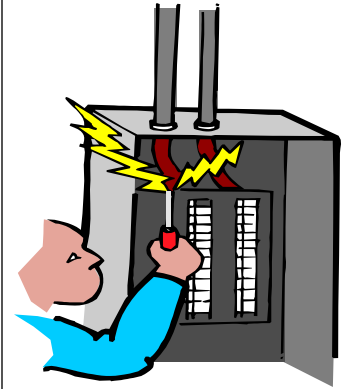
